

All candidates must choose a “**Deputy Mayor**” running-mate, a deceased person from Middleborough’s past, as well as a “**Supported Cause or Organization**”, an entity which improves Middleborough’s future, and campaign with both the person and entity during the campaign season. Middleborough’s past and future can help our cemeteries today!

NARRATIVES: We need you to tell us about yourself, your running-mate, and your supported cause. Please submit a narrative of between 400 and 500 words for each of the three campaign components. These narratives can be submitted in print form or in an email. Narratives will be used for publicity during and after this campaign, including in the Middleborough Gazette and on the various FoMC (including our Honorary Mayor of Middleborough) Facebook pages.

PHOTOS: Pictures are worth 1000 words, and pictures get you noticed. We need photos of yourself, your running-mate, and your supported cause. Your photos should be expressive of who you are. Your running-mate’s photos should reflect who they were. Your supported cause should be an image that represents them well, such as their own logos or curbside image. Again, FoMC will use these for publicity purposes.

Nomination papers are not considered submitted without the narratives and photos.

PLAN TO HAVE FUN: The title of Honorary Mayor is an honorific. While there are no compulsory activities involved, the Mayor will be asked by the FoMC and possibly other community organizations to “play the role”. We hope that the eventual winner will embrace the title and have fun doing so. Previous Mayors have been in the 4th of July and Christmas parades, been a presence at the various festivals in town, and promoted businesses and organizations. Being Mayor has been a rewarding experience for the 4 people who have earned the title so far. 2019 is Middleborough’s 350th, and the next Honorary Mayor could receive lots of exposure!
