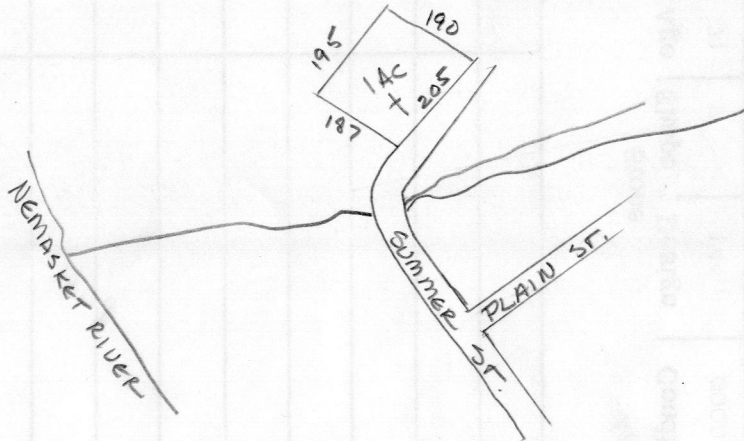
2. HISTORY OF BURIAL GROUND

"Warrentown Cemetery, one of the oldest in town, is situated on the westerly side of Summer St., between the houses formerly occupied by George Hartwell and Solomon Beals. The land was probably given by Daniel Warren in the early part of the eighteenth century."
